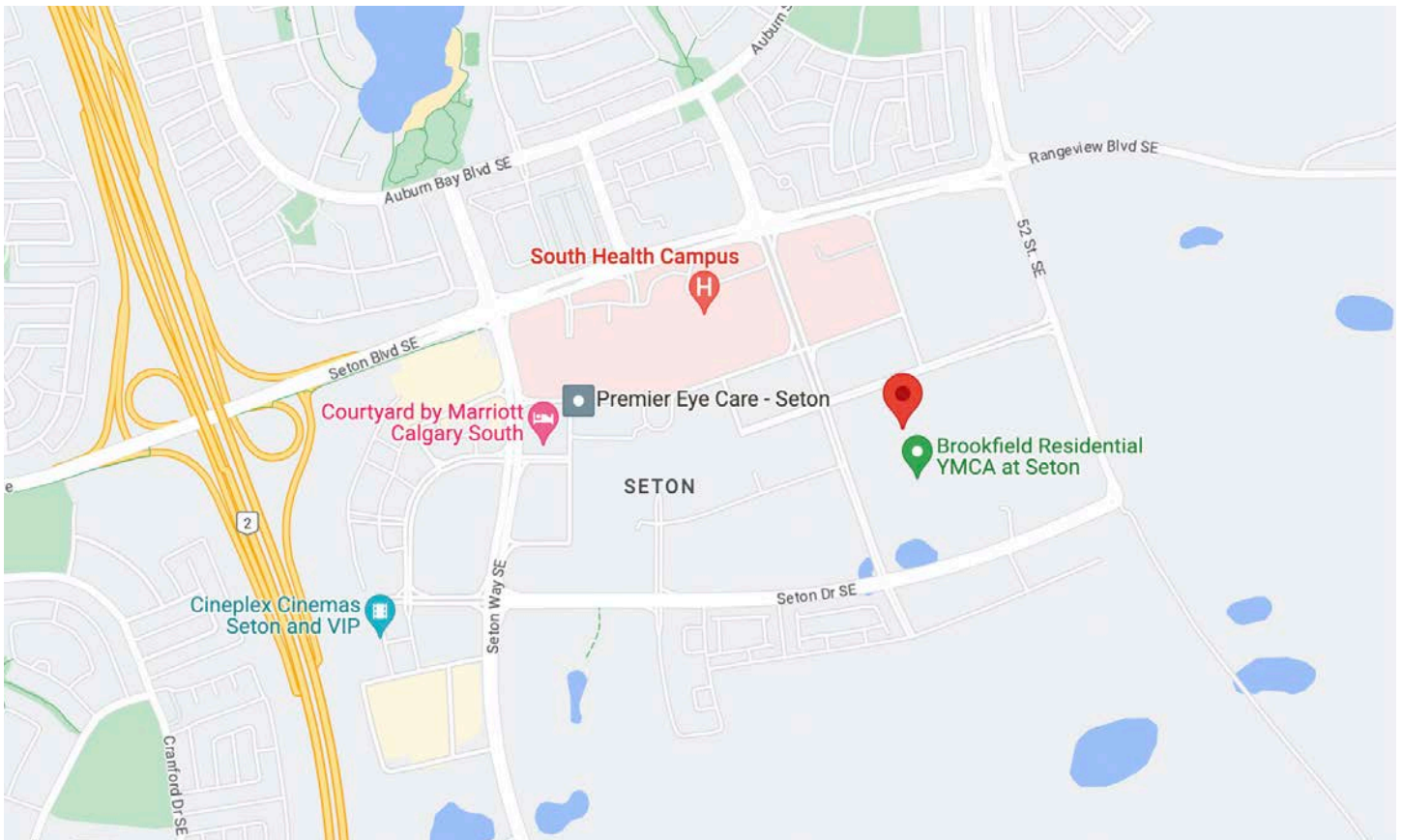
# **VENUE GUIDE**

## **Taking the bus**

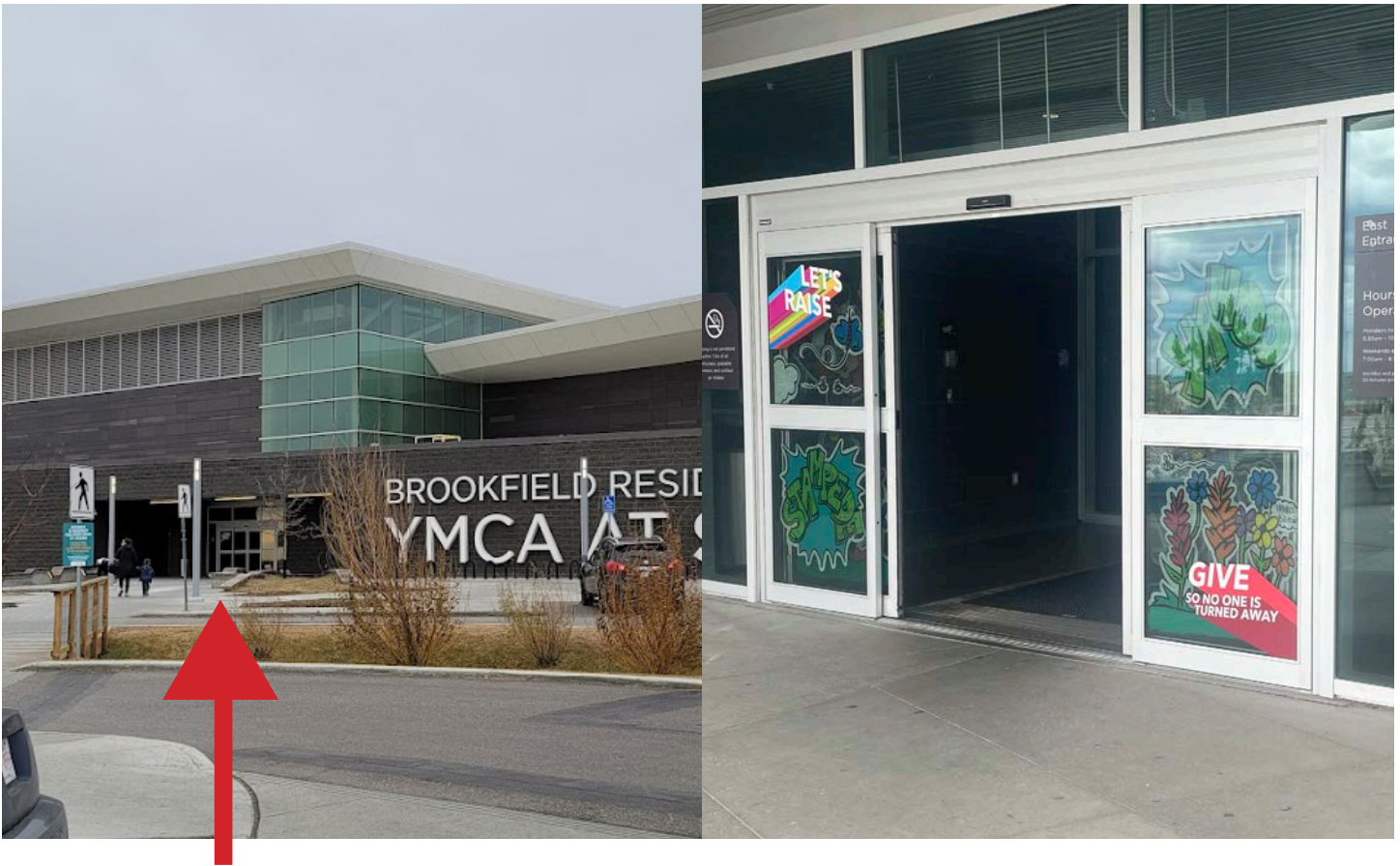
I can take the number 14, 23, or 302 buses to Brookfield Residential YMCA at Seton. I can get off at Market Street or 45 Street and walk a short distance.

## **Taxi or Rideshare**

## **Calgary Transit Access**

There is room for Calgary Transit Access to make pickups and drop-offs in front of Brookfield Residential YMCA at Seton.

All the doors into Brookfield Residential YMCA at Seton are accessible. If I need assistance, any of the volunteers or staff would be happy to help!



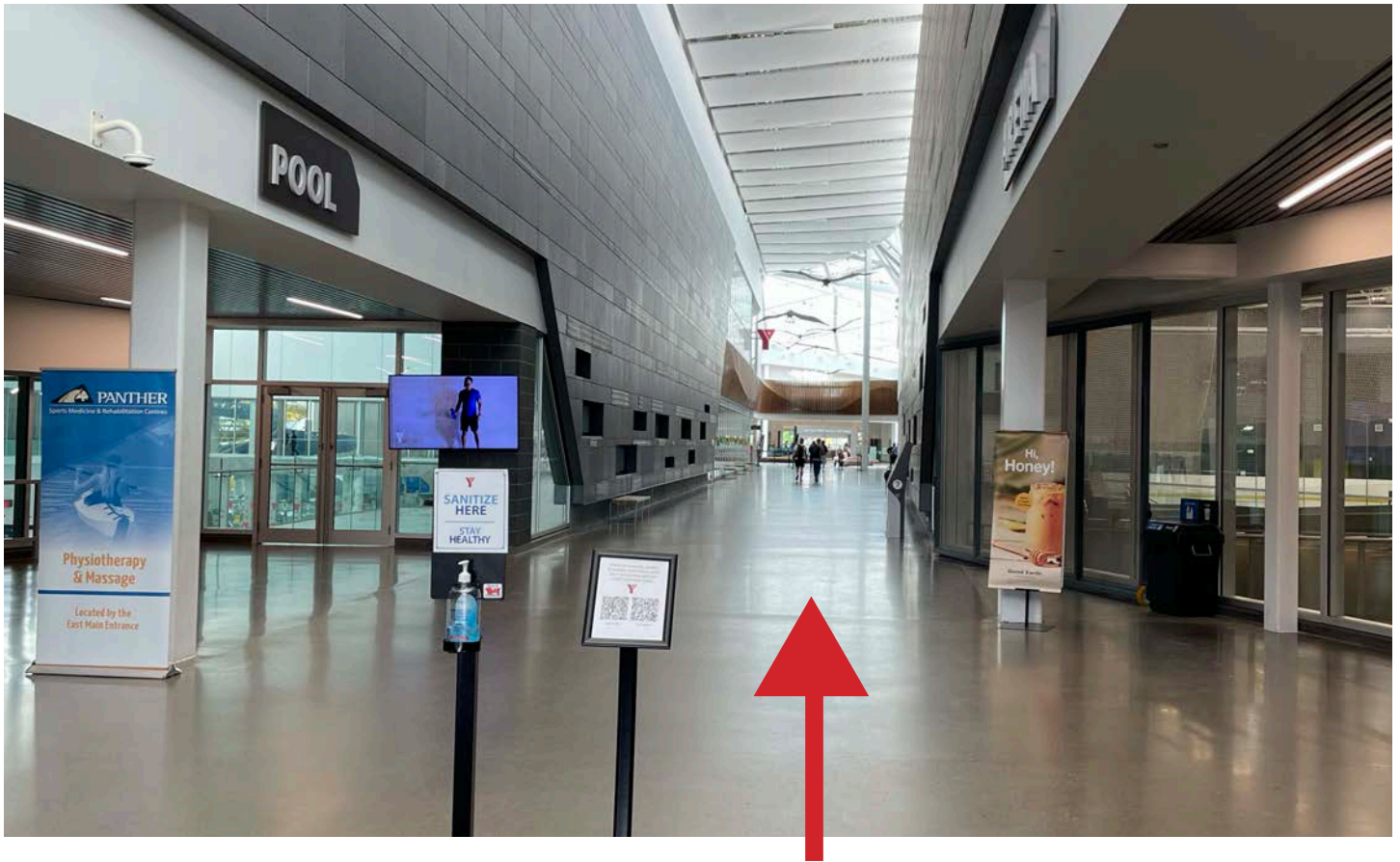
## Checking in

There is a long hallway to walk down to get to the theatre. There will be signs and friendly staff and volunteers in the hallway to show me the way!



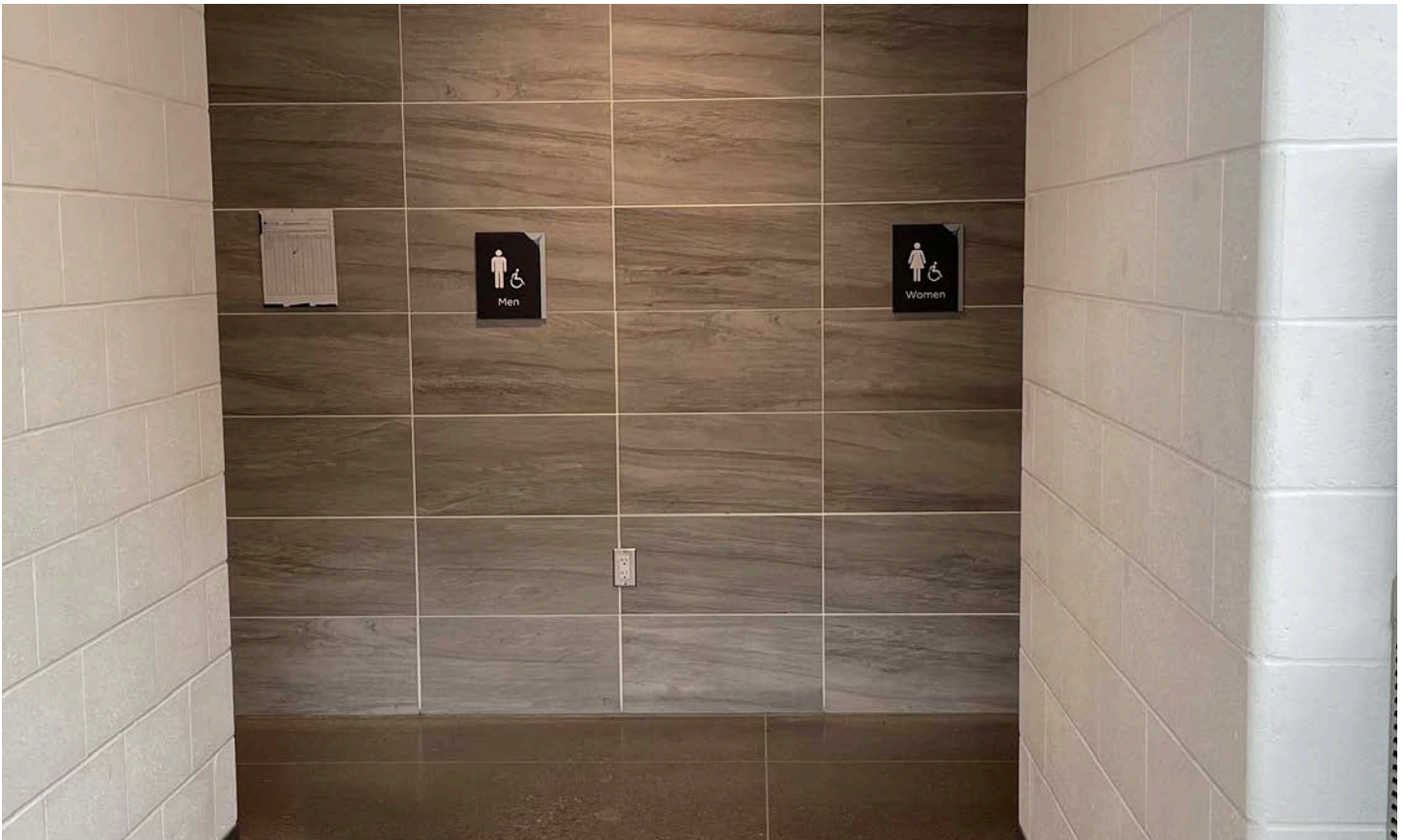


## Seating

Once I am in the theatre, I can sit anywhere. I can even sit on the floor!

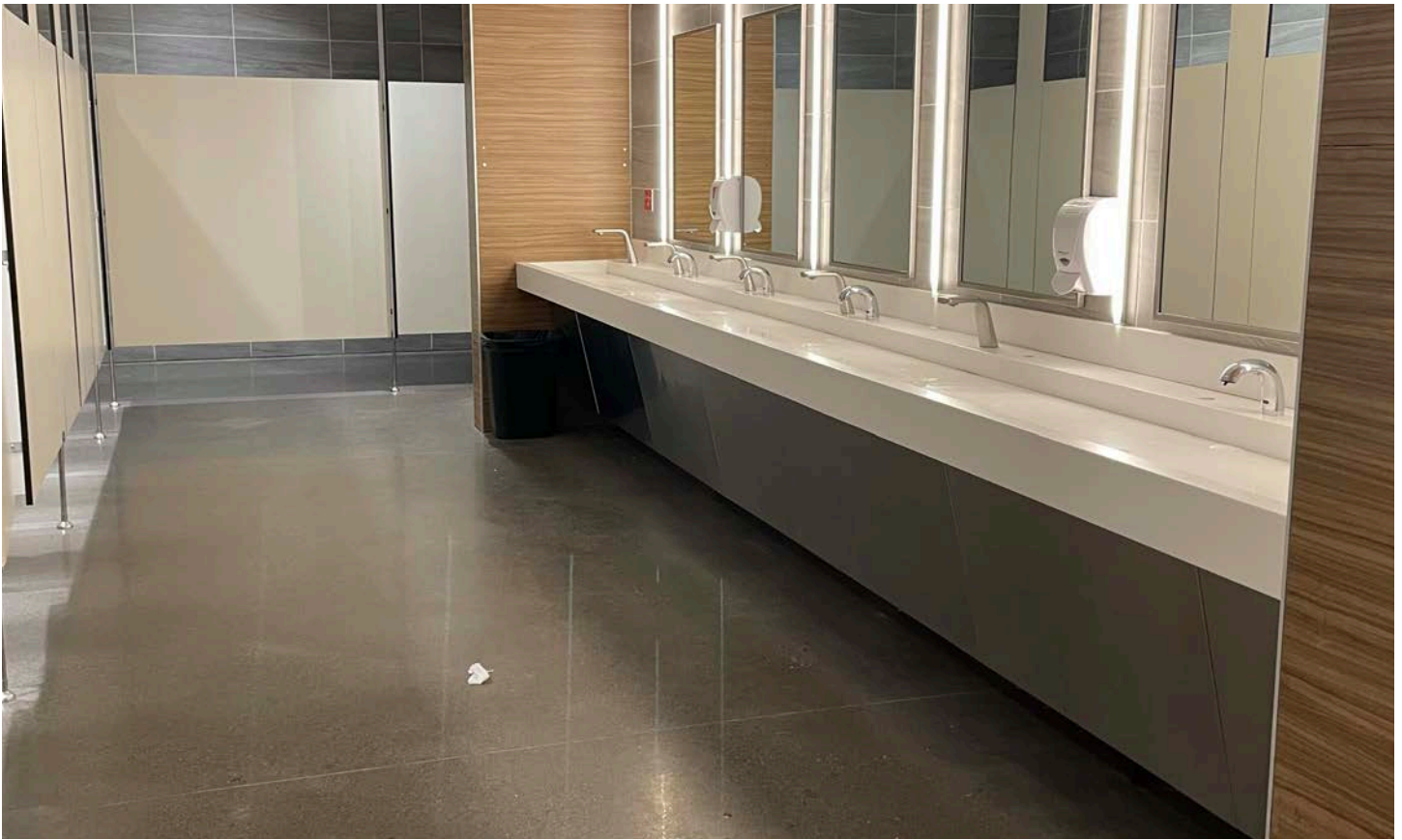
There is room for mobility devices around the theatre and all the chairs are moveable so I can move them I need.
