St. Stephen's Anglican Church 1121 14 Ave SW






St. Stephen's Anglican Church

This is the front entrance of St. Stephen's Anglican Church. The venue is located at **1121 14 Ave SW**. The volunteers or staff will greet me as I enter through the front doors.







Getting to St. Stephen's Anglican Church

St. Stephen's Anglican Church is located on 14 Avenue, between 10 Street and 11 Street.





I can take the bus, taxi, rideshare, or Calgary Transit Access to get to the church.

Taking the bus

I can take the number 6 or 90 buses going Westbound. Both buses will take me along 14 Street. I can get off at the 14 Avenue stop and walk East along 14 Avenue for five minutes (or two blocks). The church will be on my right side between 10 Street and 11 Street.

Taxi or Rideshare

There is room for taxis or rideshare vehicles in front of St. Stephen's Anglican Church. If I need assistance I can ask any of the volunteers or staff to help me call a taxi.

Calgary Transit Access

There is room for Calgary Transit Access to make pickups and drop-offs in front of St. Stephen's Anglican Church.







Entering St. Stephen's Anglican Church

There are two doors to enter St. Stephen's Anglican Church. One in front and one on the right side.







Accessible entrance

The door on the right side is accessible. If I need assistance, any of the volunteers or staff would be happy to help!







Checking in

I will meet friendly staff and volunteers inside and outside the church. I can check in with them!








Fidgets

I can also ask staff and volunteers to help me!








Getting to the washrooms
